 through 12, Higher Education, Adult Education and Vocational Training, and to work collectively to

- 3. Teach and mobilize youth leaders to address issues within their schools and community using the Empowerment Congress Model.
- 4. Collaborate and build partnerships with other EC committees, local businesses and organizations to explore options and strategies for increasing educational accessibility and outcomes (achievement).
